## VISION STATEMENT

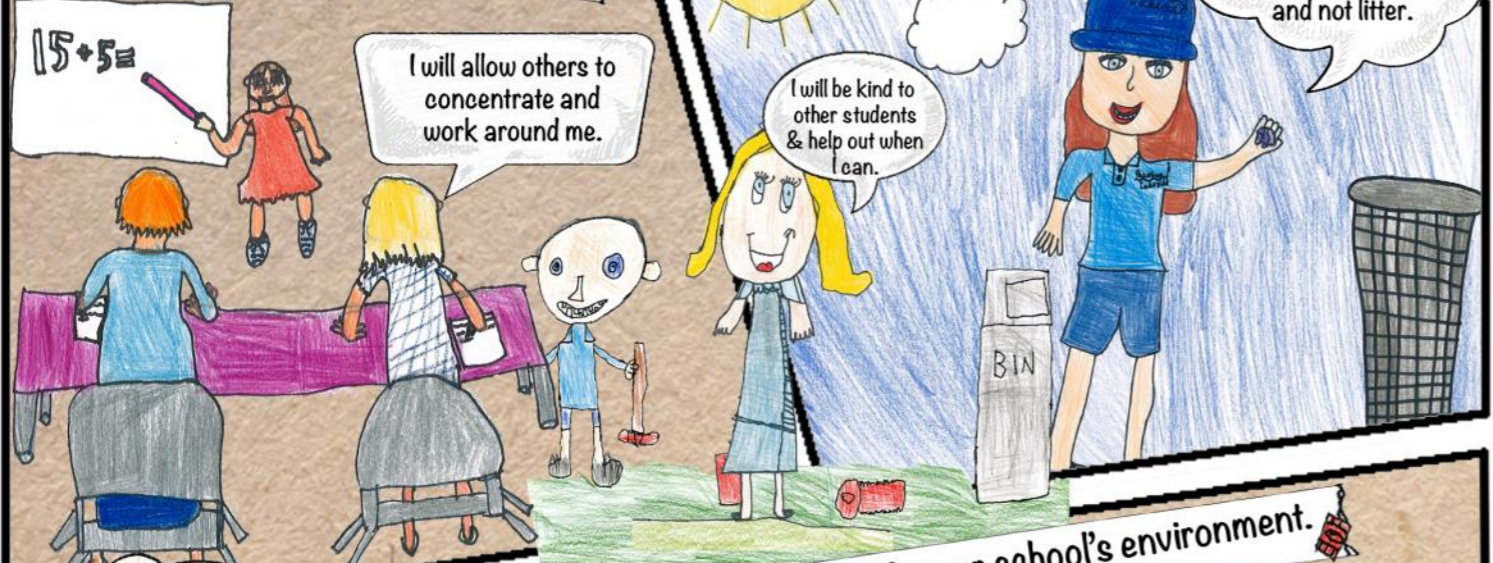

I will use the rubbish bins and not litter.

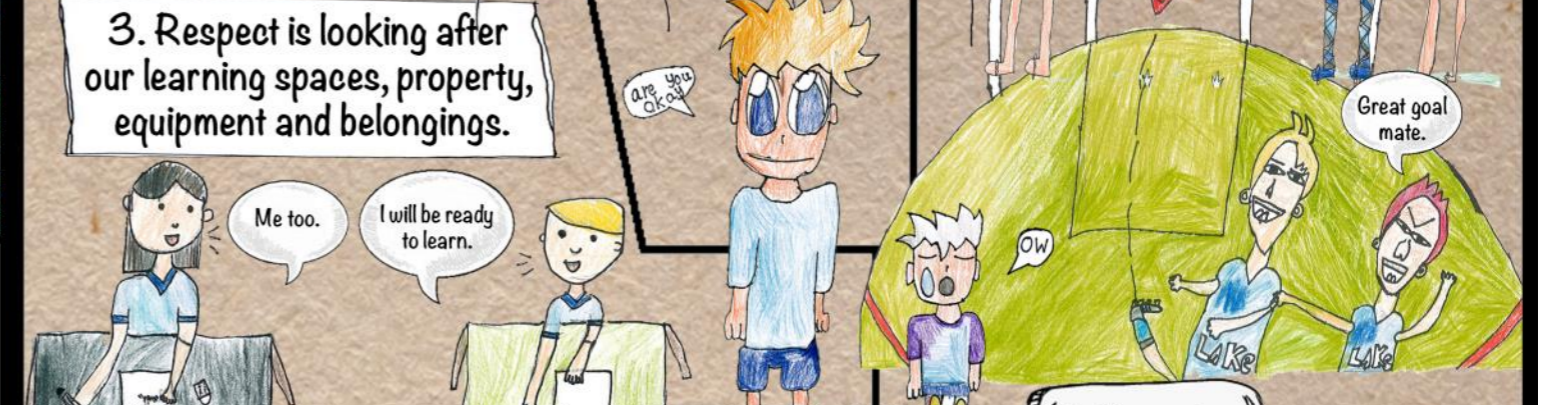
2. Respect is caring for our school's environment.

We will wear our hats in first and fourth terms.

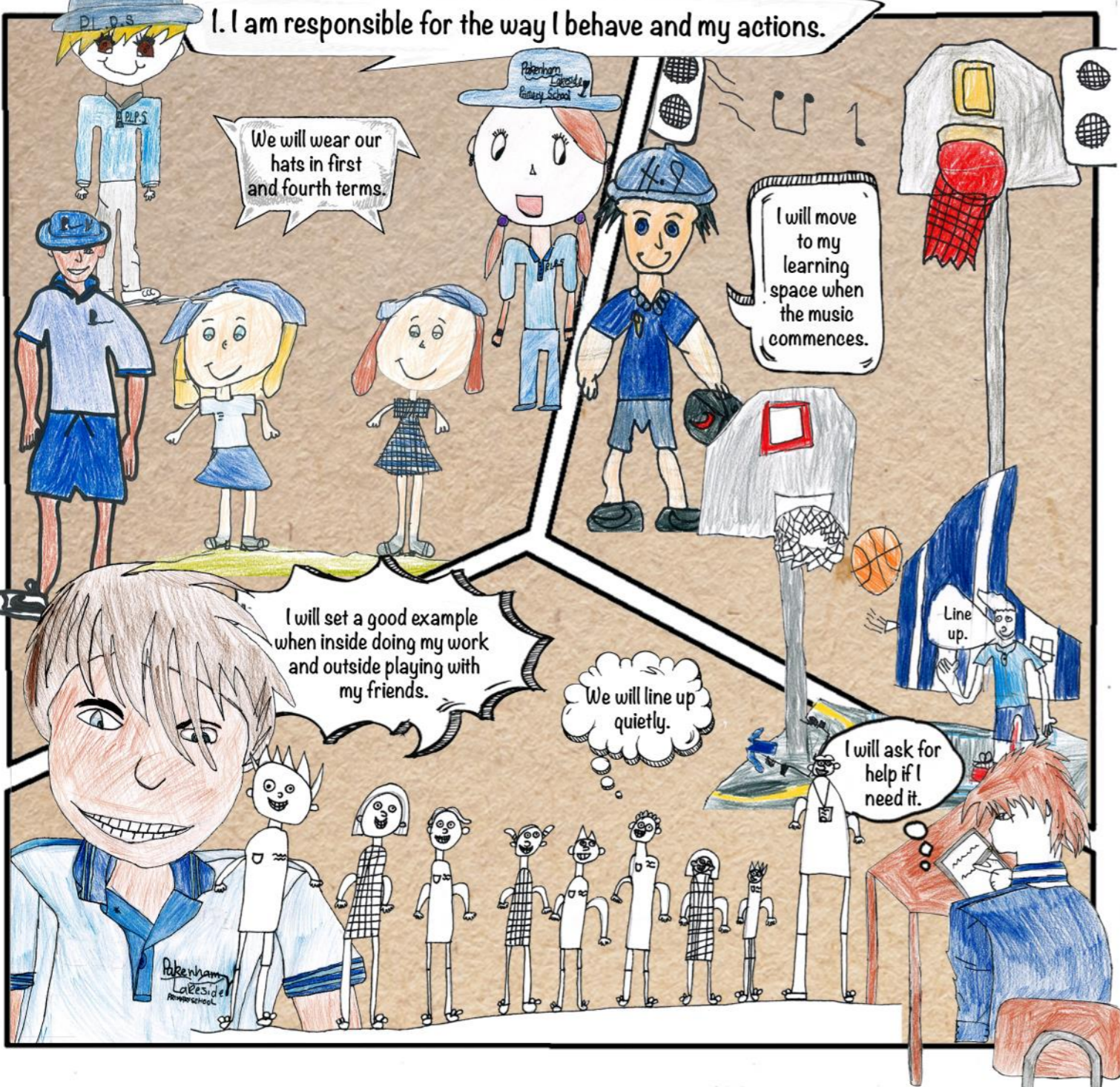
I will move to my learning space when the music commences.

I will pack up after myself.

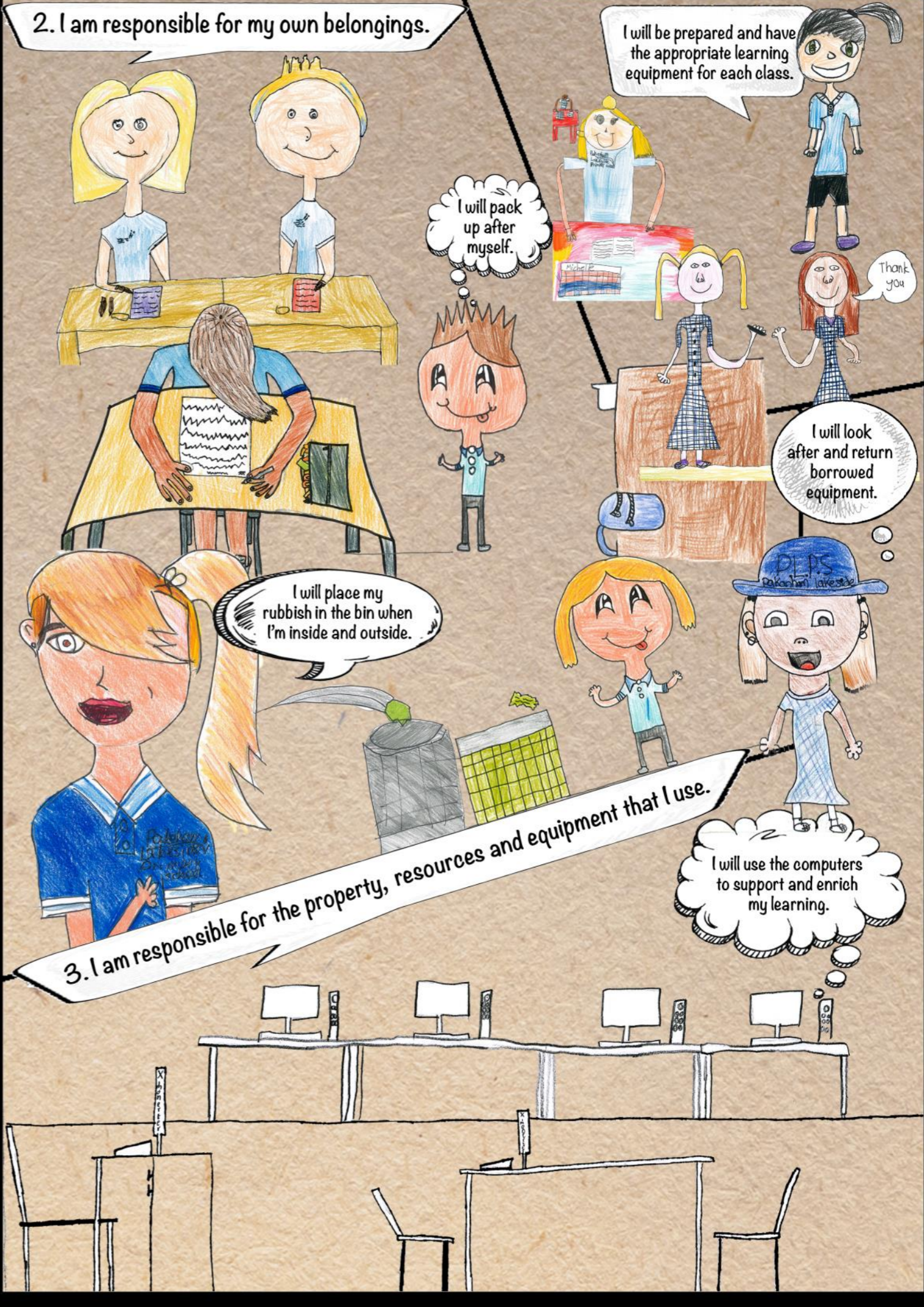

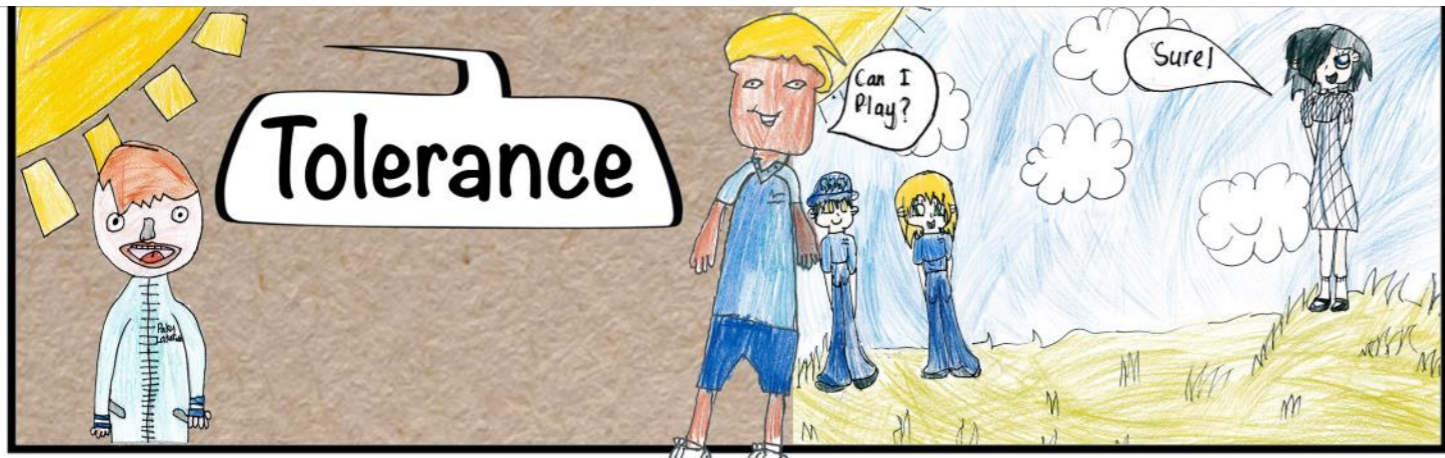
I will look after and return borrowed equipment.

I will place my rubbish in the bin when I'm inside and outside.

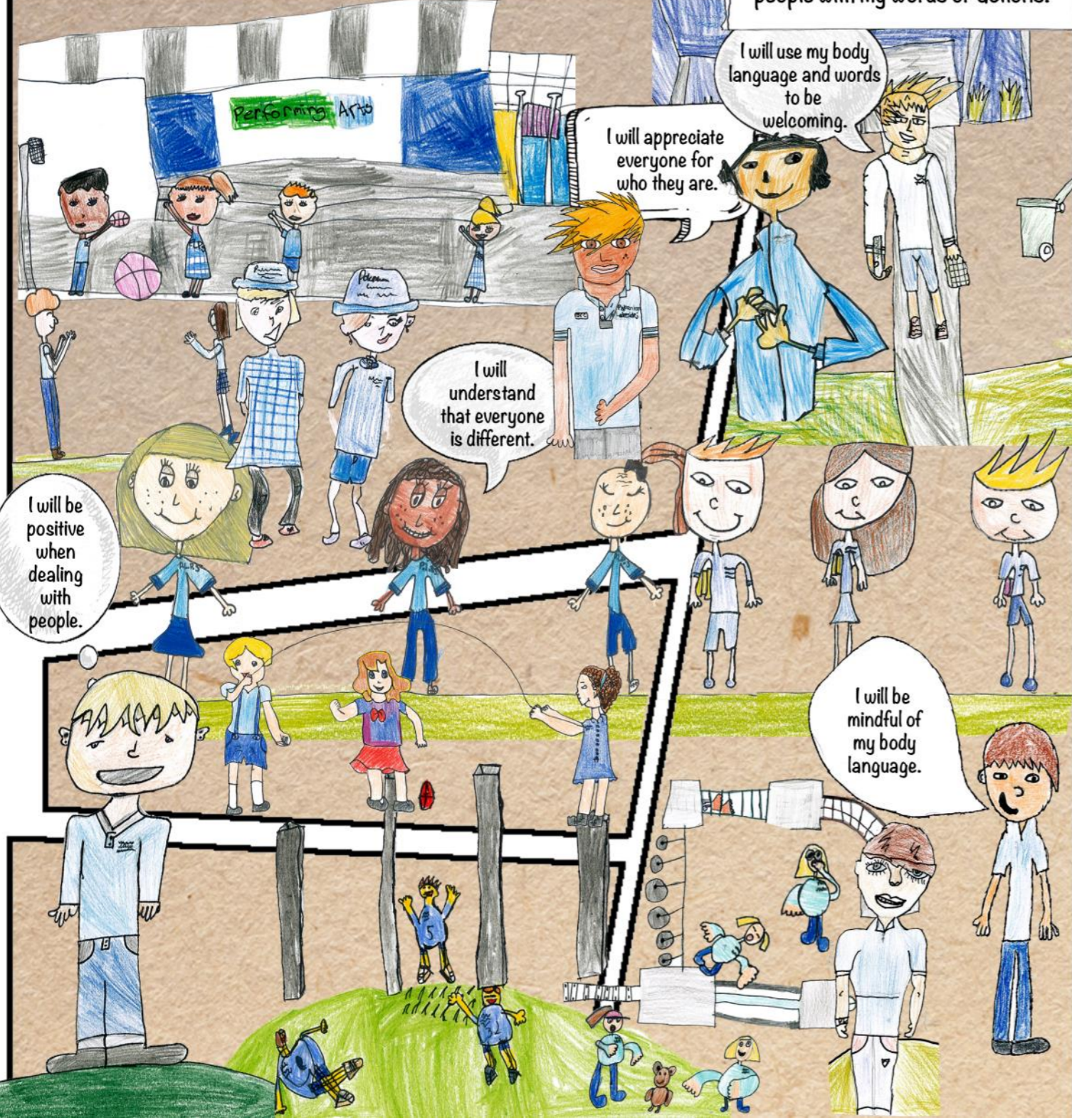
I will use the computers to support and enrich my learning.

I will always try my best.

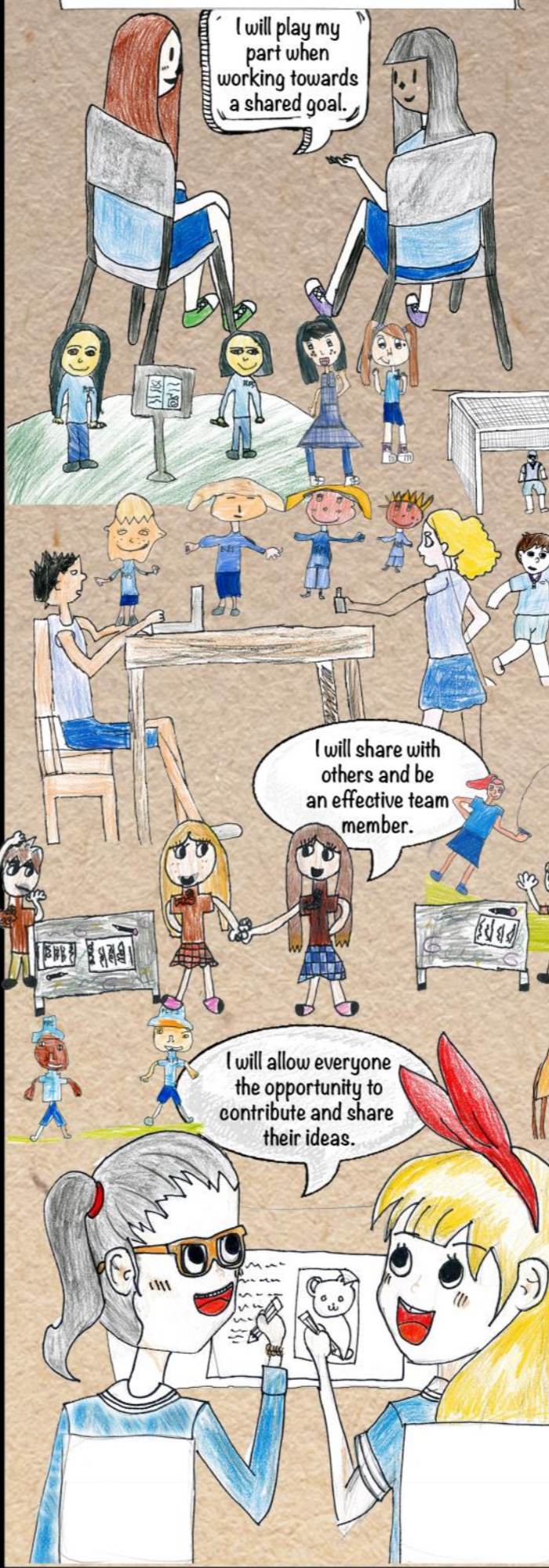

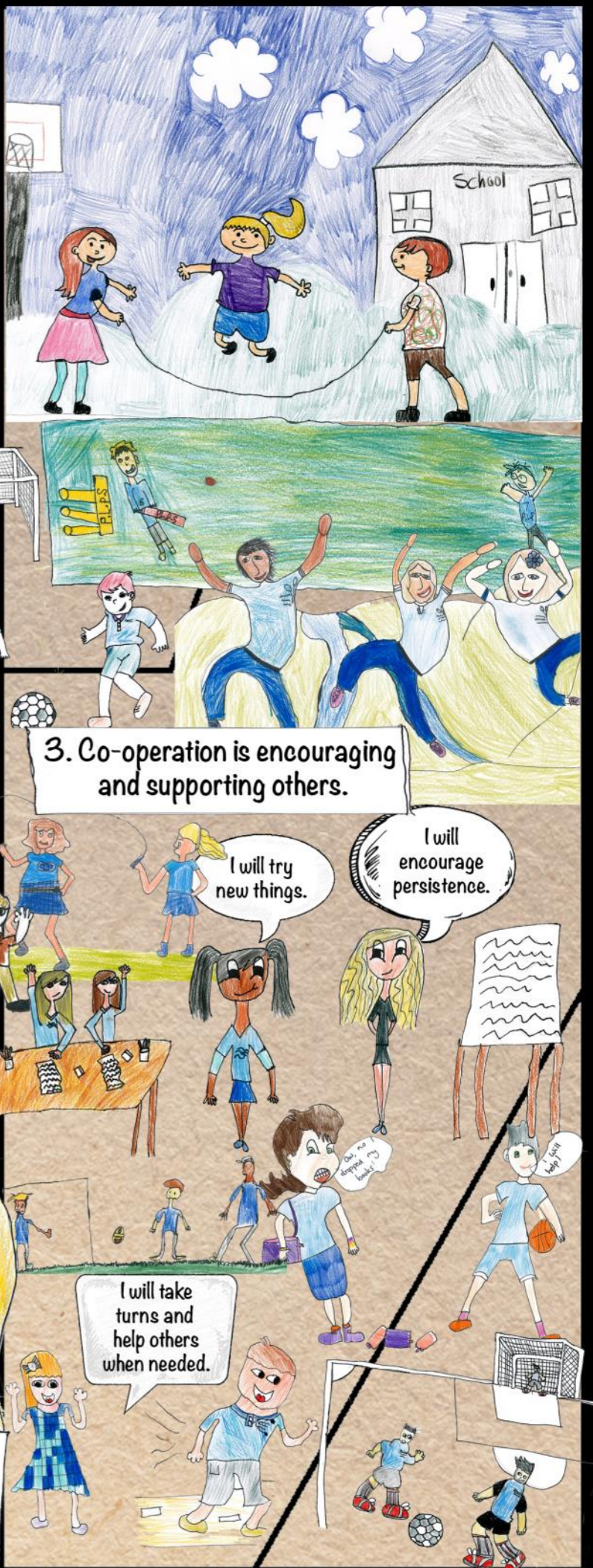
1. Co-operation is working effectively as a team member.
