Principal's Report

On behalf of our staff, I would like to thank those parents who have taken the opportunity to participate in our parent/ teacher conversations today. Your commitment to your child's learning and education is much appreciated by our staff. Well done to our students in years 3 to 6 who participated in the student-led conferences with their parents and teacher. This process enables our students to share their successes, accept responsibility and to be accountable for the learning they have participated in during our first semester of school. Our parent/teacher conversations are also an important communication tool that enables teachers, parents and students to reflect on the student's academic growth and their personal development, as well as having a clear understanding on what the key learning directions and priorities are for semester 2, 2022.

On Friday, June 3rd Pakenham Lakeside Primary School was represented by a number of our students at the Divisional level for Cross Country. Congratulations to Liam Rezen Kersevan, Henry Nellen, Jordan Brough, Justin Oroma, and Cooper Wilson who then went on to compete at the Regional level Cross Country. We also observed and conducted lots of science experiments, like elephants toothpaste and crazy currants.






Writing






