### **Principal's Report**

Although it is only early term three, already planning has commenced for our 2023 school year with a number of management processes commencing, including the crucial strategies around our staffing profile for next year. The main component around this key planning aspect is ensuring we have accurate data around our student enrolments for 2023. Our Prep enrolment numbers play a key role in developing our plans. If you are intending to enroll your child for Prep at PLPS for next year, it would be much appreciated if you can address this so your child may participate in our Transition program, which will be beginning early next term. If you are aware of any families who are considering our school for their child next year, it would be much appreciated if you could encourage them to contact our school and arrange their enrolment. Thank you for your support and assistance with this important part of our planning for the future.

An open afternoon for parents and students to visit the current Prep learning spaces has been scheduled for Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, 3:30pm to 4:30pm. Learning spaces will be open for students to participate in a variety of activities and meet our current Prep and Specialist teachers.

Yesterday, our Preps students were very excited and had an enjoyable day celebrating being at school for 101 days. It is incredible the amount of learning and growth they have demonstrated over this time. The students celebrated through participating in some special activities such as making cookies to take home and bringing along a special lunch for the day.

One of the highlights of our school calendar is the celebration of Book Week. The theme this year is "Dreaming with eyes open.." and the celebrations will take place from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> August to Friday 26<sup>th</sup> August. One of the highlights will be students coming to school dressed as their favourite book character on Tuesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Each year level will also organise some special activities or events within their learning space to promote the love of reading and books.

The sporting calendar has been very busy of late and continuing to fill with Hooptime and final playoffs for some of our winter sports teams. On Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup> thirty eight students from years 5 & 6 will be attending Hooptime at the Cardinia Life Stadium. Many thanks to Mr Vann and Mr Seton for their organisation and preparation for our students to attend this event.

Three of our winter sport teams have been successful at the recent division competition and have proceeded through to the next round of competition. Our girls T-Ball will be competing on Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup> and our boys T-Ball on Tuesday, August 16<sup>th</sup> in Mornington. Our boys soccer will also be competing on Tuesday,

August 23<sup>rd</sup> at Casey Fields. Thank you to the parents who are assisting with transport to each of these events. We wish all the teams the best of luck.

Our year 2 students be attending an excursion to Gumbuya World next Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup> and will participate in learning activities to support their learning in their Unit of Inquiry on Australian Animals. These types of learning experiences enable our children to make real life connections to the learning that is taking place at school.

Next Thursday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, "Reptile Encounters" will be setting up in our year 1 learning space, bringing with them many mini beasts for our students to enjoy. The students will have the opportunity to get up close and personal with a variety of these creatures to extend their knowledge and understanding of mini beasts and the important role they play in our lives.

Over the past couple of years, COVID regulations have limited the role parents and volunteers have been able to play within our classrooms. As these regulations are no longer in place, we would like to invite parent helpers and volunteers back into our classrooms. There will be COVID safety measures parent and classroom helpers will need to adhere to.

In our last newsletter, an overview of the new Child Safe Standards were outlined. As part of the updated guidelines and policies, all volunteers will be required to participate in an induction session on child safety and wellbeing. 
