Principal's Report

As the school year draws to a close there are many events and activities happening for our students.

Last Friday 45 students from year 3 and 4 participated in the T20 Blast Cricket tournament. Students and staff had an enjoyable and successful day. Thank you to Mr Vann for his organization of the day and to Mr Seton, Ms Dalzotto, Ms Watson, Mr Douglas and Ms Vannes for coaching and supporting the students at this event.

On Tuesday this week our year 1 students attended their excursion to Old Gippstown. The visit was to support their history unit investigating and comparing changes over time including the experiences of family life and exploring the differences in shops, schools, towns, housing, games and movies of now and early settlement. After many of the students participated in a school session of the past, they were very pleased to be going to school in today's times.

This week saw the conclusion of the students' "UP Sessions". This involved the students in years prep to 5 visiting the learning spaces they will be using in 2023. The sessions were conducted by the teachers currently in those years to provide and overview of what the students can expect as they move into their new year level. The students and staff are currently organising the final touches and we are all looking forward to celebrating the completion their Primary School education.

Our students, with the support of their Performing Arts and home group teachers have been busy rehearsing their songs. All grades are performing as well as our Choir and OSHclub. The children have been working hard to get ready for this exciting event and we sincerely hope you are able to attend. The school gates will be opened at 1.20pm to allow family and friends to enter and set themselves up for the concert, starting at

YEAR 2 - HISTORY

On Wednesday the 9th of November the Year 2 students completed their history unit "Swamp to Suburb" by visiting several important sites in the Pakenham township.

One of their destinations was the Pakenham train station where students discussed the future changes that will be made to the Pakenham train line and station area.





Students also studied the Pakenham War Memorial outside the library and noted when World War I and 2 occurred and other wars where local people were casualties. The stones alongside with the dates of other wars were also discussed.





A Local History Librarian from the Pakenham Library gave the groups a presentation that showed how Pakenham looked in the past and discussed why changes were made. The students were amazed at the old photos showing life in early Pakenham.



Students took a walk down Main Street and compared what changes have taken place over time by looking at photos of several old buildings.





The Main Street walk concluded with students sketching Mr Yakkerboo, from his statue by the pedestrian crossing.







After lunch and a play on the playground, students returned to school by bus. The excursion reflection revealed the interest and learning that had occurred for the students during the very successful excursion.
