Principal's Report

In follow up from last week's newsletter we are proud to congratulate Simrat from Grade 6 who has been awarded the winner of the Grade 5/6 category of the Lions Club of Pakenham Junior Public Speaking competition. Simrat will move on to the district semi-final which is being held in the first week of term 4 and we wish him all the best. All our representatives were a credit to our school and deserve to be very proud of their efforts. Thank you to Mrs Ross, Mrs Allen and Mr Runting for their organisation and support of this great initiative.

Last Monday our Year Five students participated in their Science Discovery Dome incursion. Starlab Victoria set up a large inflatable dome and used digital projections, animations, video clips and modelling to replicate our skies to extend their knowledge and learning to our students. They thoroughly enjoyed seeing and hearing about the elements and structure of the different planets and the way in which the forces of gravity work.

This week our Preps participated in an incursion facilitated by CARP Productions titled "Happy Being Me!" that supported their learning about friendship and personal strengths through their Social and Emotional Learning unit. The production explored themes of friendship, the importance of happiness, self-esteem, acceptance of others and feeling positive. The word 'deadly' is an Aboriginal English translation meaning fantastic/great/awesome. This is the third annual event involving schools across the Cardinia Schools' network to celebrate and learn about Indigenous culture. Students participated in a Welcome to Country, sports and art activities, a yarning circle and a scavenger hunt. A sausage sizzle lunch was provided by the Rotary Club and a great day was had by all! Thank you to Mr Krug, Ms Olszewski, Ms Macdonald and Mr Douglas for their organization and attendance at this event.
