Principal's Report

Yesterday a notice was placed on Compass outlining the date change of our Art Show. As outlined in the communication to our families, there is a substantial amount of rain expected next Monday, therefore we have transferred the Art Show to Tuesday after school, as the forecast is much more favourable. The program for the afternoon will remain the same. **Art Show – Tuesday, 2nd December from 3:30pm to 7:00pm.** Official welcome, presentations and awards will be at 5:00pm on the stage adjoining the outdoor basketball courts. We look forward to showcasing the effort and creations produced by our students throughout their Visual Arts classes in 2025.

Well done to everyone involved with our recent Year 4 camp to Woorabinda. Nestled in the heart of nature, our students delved into an array of challenging activities and immersive learning experiences. Walking into a beautiful bush setting on the first day and cooking their own lunch was an adventure and made a little more difficult with the wet weather. Having the opportunity to spend a day with our year 4 students on Tuesday, it was great to see many students attempt and persevere with some of the challenging and new activities such as the high ropes course, with many overcoming their nerves and completing the course. On behalf of our students and parents, I would like to extend my appreciation to our staff for their commitment and support of your children as they assisted the students to ensure they had an enjoyable time, whilst participating in the various activities on camp.

On Tuesday our year 1 students had a visit from the RACV Safety Squad. The RACV Safety Squad conducts a program that aims to empower students to stay safe both at home and on the roads through interactive sessions with qualified educators. The themes the squad covered were passenger safety, pedestrian safety, bike safety and identifying hazards in the home. The program was a timely reminder of things our students need to consider to keep themselves safe.

Today our Year 2 students will be participating in an Extended Day. This is provided as an introduction to PLPS' school camping program. Students are offered the opportunity to stay later after the regular conclusion of the school day. The afternoon will include afternoon tea, dinner and some activities to encourage the development of social interactions and collaboration with their peers whilst in a familiar environment. The event is also aimed at supporting the transition to Year 3.

An upcoming and exciting event is our Year 6 Graduation evening. We are looking forward to celebrating with our Year 6 students and their families on Tuesday, December 9th as we acknowledge the conclusion of their Primary education from Pakenham Lakeside Primary School. The Graduation evening will be conducted at the Cardinia Cultural Centre. Students need to be at the Cultural Centre at 6:15pm with family and friends being welcomed into the function from 6:45pm for a 7:00pm start.

Our year 5/6 basketball team has continued their success at the recent regional Hoop Time competition. The team have been

rewarded and will now be competing in the State Hoop Time Basketball finals on Tuesday, December 2nd at the State Basketball Centre in Wantirna South. This is such a fabulous effort to be playing at this level of competition. We wish them the best of luck on the day. Thanks to Mr Seton for the organisation and coaching of the team. Parents are most welcome to come along to support the team.

Our Year 1 students will be beginning their swimming program on Monday, December 1st at Splash's Swim School. The program consists of eight 45-minute swimming classes facilitated by Splash's staff. The swimming program will run each day except for Wednesday, over the next two weeks. The swimming program is a Department of Education funded initiative, therefore there is no cost to the families for our students to participate in these lessons. Parents are welcome to attend and observe the swimming lessons in line with Splash's policies and procedures.

Our Year 2 students will return to Gumbuya World on Wednesday, December 10th. The offer to have a second day at the park free of charge, was extended to us as their initial visit was hampered by terrible weather whereby shows and exhibitions were unable to run. The staff and students are looking forward to returning to Gumbuya World and enjoying a full experience of the park, particularly the 'Birds of Prey' show.

A reminder that next Wednesday, December 3rd is a curriculum day, and our students do not attend school on this day. Our OSHClub will be operating a full day's program to support our parents and families on this day. Important Information - Parking and Road Safety

Dear Parents and Carers

We have recently been contacted by Cardinia Shire Council regarding a concerning increase in reports regarding illegal parking, dangerous driving and pedestrian safety around schools, across the shire.

Together with Cardinia Shire Council, we wish to remind drivers of the importance of safety and adhering to the road rules when parking around the school, at pick up and drop off times.

To ensure the safety of all pedestrians, students and members of our school community, we ask that you:

- Park only in designated areas: Parking is not permitted in or across driveways, on nature strips, no-stopping zones, no-parking zones, bus zones, or areas reserved for staff. Please adhere to all signage and the road rules.
- Follow drop-off and pick-up procedures: Use the designated drop-off and pick-up zones to ensure a smooth and safe flow of traffic.
- Be mindful of pedestrians: Follow directions from School Crossing Supervisors and take extra caution during peak times when children are arriving or leaving school.
- Be respectful: Council Parking Officers are required to conduct regular patrols around schools to ensure safety. Please be respectful, and courteous.
